Redondo Beach schedules three public workshops for waterfront revitalization

Redondo Beach has selected three days of public workshops for the Draft Environmental Impact Report for the revitalization of the waterfront.

The \$300 million project proposal by CenterCal has been inspected by environmental experts for the last 18 months. The Redondo Beach City Council will receive the report at its Nov. 17 meeting. The report will be available at the city's website, <u>redondo.org</u>, in both city libraries, and at the public counters at city hall.

There will be three community workshops:

Wednesday, Dec. 9, from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. on the second floor of the Redondo Beach Main Library

Saturday, Jan. 9, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Crowne Plaza Hotel

The meetings will include a presentation on the results of the environmental analysis and a comment period which will be open to the public.
